<b>Methodology</b>	<b>20 Points</b> The proposal clearly identifies the population to be studied, the study design, data collection methods, instruments (when appropriate) and data analysis procedures.	<b>15 Points</b> Portions of the methodology are either missing or incomplete.	<b>0 Points</b> Methodology is not accurate or organized.		
<b>Expected applications for making a difference in nursing practice</b>	<b>20 Points</b> Expected implications for nursing/healthcare or education are clearly stated and are supported by scholarly resources.	<b>10 Points</b> Either the paper does not clearly state expected implications for nursing/healthcare or education, or it is not supported by scholarly resources.	<b>0 Points</b> The expected implications for nursing/healthcare or education are absent or unclear and unsupported by scholarly resources.		
<b>References, Grammar, APA</b>	<b>10 Points</b> The paper illustrates mastery of the basics of sentence structure, word choice, and spelling. The paper is correctly formatted to APA style. At least three scholarly resources are cited.	<b>5 Points</b> The paper contains some grammatical, spelling, punctuation or APA formatting errors. Less than three scholarly resources are cited.	<b>0 Points</b> The paper contains spelling, and grammatical errors that make it difficult to read. APA formatting is not followed. No scholarly resources are cited.
